Meeting Minutes

June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023

## **Opening**

The regular meeting of the Riders MC was called to order at 8:03pm on June 8<sup>th</sup>, 2023 in Gravelton, IN by Jim Vandiver.

## **Approval of Minutes**

Mont Annis read the treasurer's report. The previous cash balance as of 05/01/2023 was \$1,833.37. Membership Revenue was \$1,790 and included \$1090 in Paypal and cash of \$700. Debits for utilities were \$33 and \$100 to Cripes. Payment for the contractor that worked on the track was \$1525. Insurance for Open Ride was \$420 to Birdsong and payments to Noble County for property spring taxes for \$53.23 by check and an online payment of \$577.60. I also transferred \$800 to checking from savings leaving a balance in Checking as 05/31/2023 of \$1,121.80. The saving account beginning balance was \$36,118.56 After transferring \$800 to checking and including interest income of \$0.30 leaves an ending balance of \$35,318.31. Jerry Yoder motioned to accept. Harry Coplin seconded.

Joe Vandiver read the meeting minutes from May. Mont Annis motioned to accept. Harry Coplin seconded.

## **Old Business**

The open ride went really well. Thanks to everyone who was able to come out and help. Seth Terry and Gary Taylor are working on finalizing a plan to drop the septic tank in. It is looking like the bathroom fund will run out before completion. Mont was unable to secure a CD at this point.

Insurance is scheduled to expire on June 21<sup>st</sup>. We are still looking for a suitable replacement to insurance.

## **New Business**

Jesse Sherman has been a probationary member for one year. All present voted in favor of Jesse being a full member.

Tim Sullivan's son has been working with Corey Parlin, Great Lakes Motorcycle Coach. We discussed lending him the property to run a school. We would not make money but he carries his own insurance so there would be no cost to us. This would help promote both the club and the sport.
